Our mission is to interrupt the darkness by sharing God's love with those trapped in or vulnerable to sexual exploitation. We aim to help those who are caught in sexual exploitation walk freely into their destinies as sons and daughters of God.

The Amber Foundation collects airline kits and hotel toiletries and repurposes them into Men's and Women's kits for street sleepers, refugees and the elderly.

We will hear from a speaker about the work that Sons and Daughters does, and then spend time packaging kits and writing cards for Sons and Daughters and other agencies to use.
