In partnership with Hong Kong Church Network for the Poor (HKCNP), we will visit with a local church in Sham Shui Po (ECF Saint Too Canaan Church) for games and lunch at the church, followed by home visits with the elderly. **Sons and Daughters and  
the Amber Foundation**

Sons & Daughters seeks to reach out to the men and women in the red-light districts of Hong Kong. Our mission is to interrupt the darkness by sharing God’s love with those trapped in or vulnerable to sexual exploitation. We aim to help those who are caught in sexual exploitation walk freely into their destinies as sons and daughters of God.

The Amber Foundation collects airline kits and hotel toiletries and repurposes them into Men’s and Women’s kits for street sleepers, refugees and the elderly.

We will hear from a speaker about the work that Sons and Daughters does, and then spend time packaging kits and writing cards for Sons and Daughters and other agencies to use.

**Prayer Walk with Teen’s Key**

This includes those who work in the sex industry, young women faced with unwanted pregnancy and/or those vulnerable to sexual health risks. We will hear a little about the organization, then go on a prayer walk through the Mong Kok/Yau Ma Tei red-light district.
