

# Frequently Asked Questions

## Can I invite my home church pastor to conduct the wedding in Chinese?

Yes, your home church pastor is welcome to jointly conduct the wedding ceremony with the Union Church pastor. The parts of the ceremony that must be conducted by a Union Church pastor are Exchange of Vows, Exchange of Rings, Signing of the Marriage Certificate and Pronouncement.

## Can I say the vows in Chinese?

Yes. You may say your vows in Chinese after saying them in English.

## I have lost my Baptism Certificate. What can I do?

A reference letter from your home church is also acceptable.

## How many people can the sanctuary seat?

220.

## At what time can the decoration team start decorating?

One hour before the wedding ceremony.

## Can my decorator come for a site visit?

## How many parking spaces does the church provide?

- Three microphones
- Music stands
- Reception table and white tablecloths
- Easel for wedding picture
- Two parking spaces (in front of the garage)
