Position Summary:

The Young Adults Director will minister to young adults, university students and single or married professionals aged from 18 – 35 years old. Providing pastoral care for young adults on a spiritual, interpersonal and social level, with the intent of supporting them in their Christian journey.

- Ability to preach would be advantageous.
